### 2010/2011 Parish Council Report

#### Council actions over the past year

- 1. New frontage to village hall. Refurbishment of bus shelter and seats.
- 2. Churchill Crescent play area re-equipped.
- 3. Successfully opposed original development plans for Lea Meadow.
- 4. Convened a public meeting re. library closure proposals . Strong resolution sent to County Council opposing closure.

#### **Administrative changes since December 2010**

- 1. Four councillors and the clerk resigned in December.
- 2. Four new councillors co-opted and new clerk (Philip Collings) appointed.
- 3. New Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Chair of Finance elected.
- 4. New Standing Orders based on national model agreed/adopted.
- 5. Committee Terms of Reference ('essential for good governance') agreed/adopted.
- **6.** General Purposes Committee abolished and its responsibilities transferred to the full council for more open decision making
- 7. Public participation/question time is now on agenda before the main items and not at the end of the meeting, allowing residents' views to be taken into account.

#### **Current Initiatives**

- 1. Reinstatement of a public toilet in accordance with residents' wishes expressed in the recent Community Plan survey.
- 2. Update of village hall sound system in plan.
- 3. New parish council website now open.
- 4. New software for accounting system I use.
- 5. J Stoves has volunteered to be our footpaths officer.
- 6. Grants: £4,500 to Chiltern Edge Youth Centre, reviewed annually. £500 to Sonning Common Magazine, reviewed annually.

£300 to The Village Gardeners

7. Liaising with Co-op to improve car park drainage.

#### **Under Consideration or planned**

- 1. Improving ventilation of village hall.
- 2. Erecting gates and fencing to Baskerville Road play area and gates to Churchill Crescent play area.
- 3. Replacing/refurbishing the village notice boards.
- 4. Taking all possible action to preserve our library and youth centre.
- 5. Continuing to encourage and support local societies and initiatives.
- 6. Close watching brief on proposals for housing development in the village and appropriate response in the light of residents' views.
- 7. Working towards becoming a Quality Council.
- 8. Taking positive steps to respond to local wishes.
