15/002	Public Question Time under Section 30 of Standing Orders: None.
15/003	Police Report: Mr Kedge thanked PCSO Boyes for his latest report and the meeting sent him best wishes for a quick recovery from his operation.
15/004	Minutes of previous meetings:
	 Planning Committee held on 17 March 2014 were presented and approved. Parish Council meeting held on 17 March 2014 were presented and approved.
15/005	County Councillor's Report: Cllr Bartholomew advised that OCC has submitted Oxfordshire's Strategic Economic Plan to Government; that the SHMA estimates that South Oxfordshire will require 15 to 16,000 new homes in the period 2011 to 2031; that Connecting Oxfordshire is being launched this month: that OCC cannot assist with the parking problems around Page's Orchard.
15/006	District Councillor's Report: Cllr Harrison advised that the Big Clean Up programme is underway; that there is to be a one year discount in May and June of 10% for new users of brown bins; SODC has set aside £150,000 until March 2015 to help pay for town and large village centre improvements; that Crimestoppers are launching a campaign to raise awareness of the effects of rural crime.
15/007	Parish Clerk's Report: Noted. The Parish Clerk was asked to find out if PCSO Boyes could be authorised to issue penalties for dog fouling.
15/008	Neighbourhood Development Plan progress: Mr Greenwood advised that the Scoping Report has been sent out for six weeks of consultation; that grants totalling £17,00 have been made towards the NDP costs; that the Working Party is working in smaller task groups in drafting the actual plan and in preparing site specifications.
15/009	Skatepark project: Mrs Lewis reported that grants of £65,000 have been awarded by Lafarge Tarmac and £15,000 by SODC. New tenders for construction are expected by 18 April. Two fundraising events are planned by the Butchers Arms and others by On Your Bike, the Annual Lunch and a Quiz Night in September.
15/010	Twinning plaque: It was resolved that the Parish Council should put up a brass plaque celebrating Sonning Common's twinning with St Luc and Guichainville at a cost less than £100.
15/011	Sonning Common Magazine Committee: It was resolved that Mr Fort will replace Mrs Phillips-Tilbury as the Parish Council's representative.
15/012	Annual Parish Meeting of Electors: Mr Kedge confirmed that the single theme on 12 May will be the proposed Third Bridge from Reading with a number of speakers confirmed. There will be a display in the lobby about the Community Governance Review.
15/013	Hedges at 33/35 Peppard Road: Mr Jones pointed out that as well as being overgrown these hedges are infested with Japanese Knotweed requiring specialist removal. It was resolved that the Parish Clerk should request OCC Highways to carry out needed works in a suitable fashion.
