#### CONSENT FOR USE OF PHOTOGRAPHS/VIDEOS

## **CONSENT FORM FOR RIDING SWEGWAYS**

# Safety Agreement and Terms and Conditions of Swegway use at Sonning Common Youth Club

This agreement **MUST** be signed before Sonning Common Youth Club will allow a young person to use a hover board/ swegway.

- 1. I acknowledge that my child's participation riding a hover board/ swegway entails known and unknown risks that could result in physical or emotional injury. Hover Boards / swegways expose participants to the risk of cuts and bruises and injuries to wrists and ankles. More serious injuries are also possible which include paralysis and death.
- 2. Use of the hover boards/swegways around the internal areas (hallways/bathrooms/seating area) and external places out of bounds is strictly forbidden any such use will result in the young person being excluded from the activity.
- Sonning Common Youth Club will issue safety instructions and equipment (helmets/knee/elbow pads) in relation to the activities and young people must comply with these at all times. Young people will be supervised whilst using the equipment and failure to follow instructions will result in exclusion from the activity.
- 4. I understand that hover boards/ swegways require a reasonable level of fitness and ability. I warrant that my child does not have (or has had) any medical condition including pregnancy that makes it dangerous to partake in such activities.
- 5. I understand that Sonning Common Youth Club will have no liability for any injury/injuries caused nor damage to or loss of any clothing, equipment, jewellery, watches, electronic devices or any other property of any description.
- 6. My child's participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and I allow them to participate in spite of the risks and with full knowledge of them.
